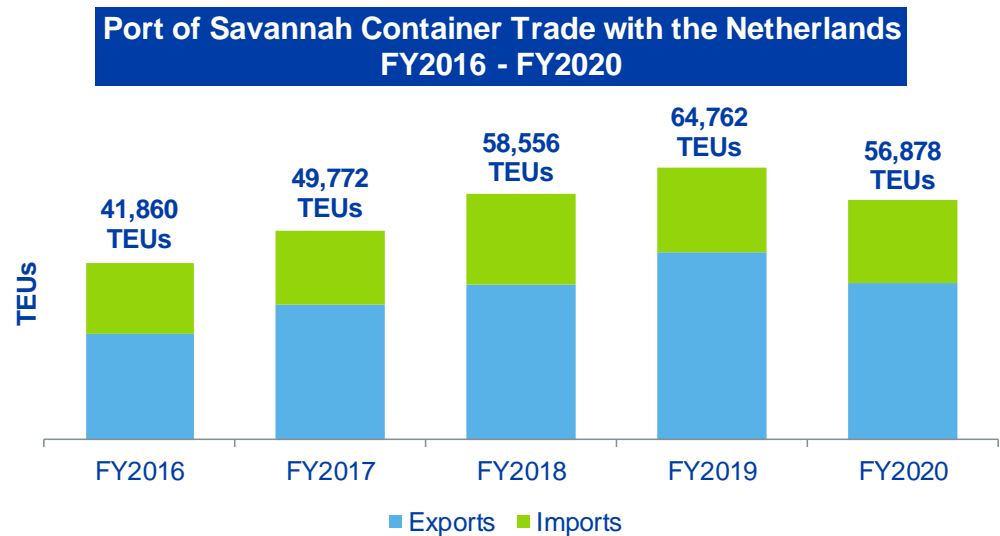

Detail Summary:

The Port of Savannah's total container trade with the Netherlands grew 36% in Fiscal Year 2020 (FY2020) vs. FY2016, or an 8% compound annual growth rate. During this time, imports from the Netherlands climbed 18% (+3,049 TEUs) and exports to the Netherlands expanded 47% (+11,969 TEUs).



The Port of Savannah handled 14% of the Netherlands' container trade via U.S. East Coast ports during FY2020.

The Netherlands accounted for 2% of the Port of Savannah's total container trade, ranking #14 among trade partner countries.

In addition to the Netherlands trade, the Port of Rotterdam handled nearly 25,000 TEUs of transshipment cargo between the Port of Savannah and Germany, Russia, France, and other European countries.

There are currently 5 direct container services between the Port of Savannah and the Port of Rotterdam. These include THE's AL2 and AL5, OCEAN's TAT2/Liberty Bridge/ATE1/TAE, 2M's TA4/NEUATL4, and CMA CGM's RTW PAD. They offer transit times from Rotterdam to Savannah in as little as 13 days and from Savannah to Rotterdam in 13 days.

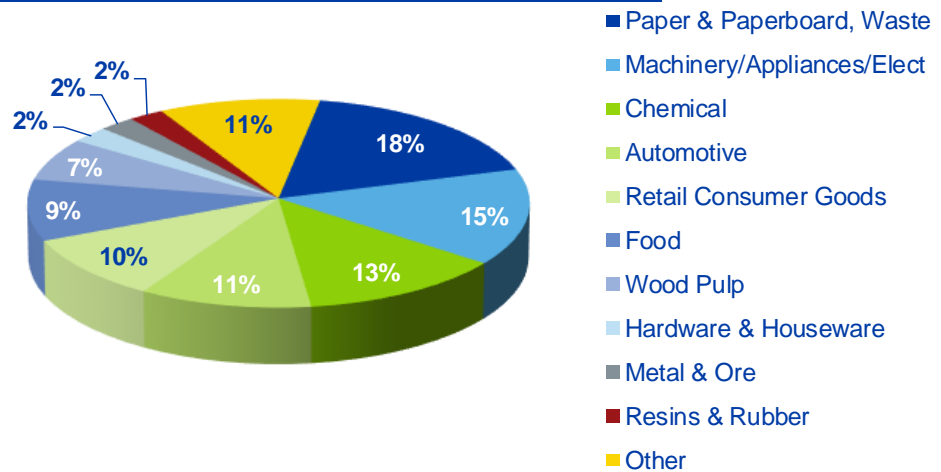
