

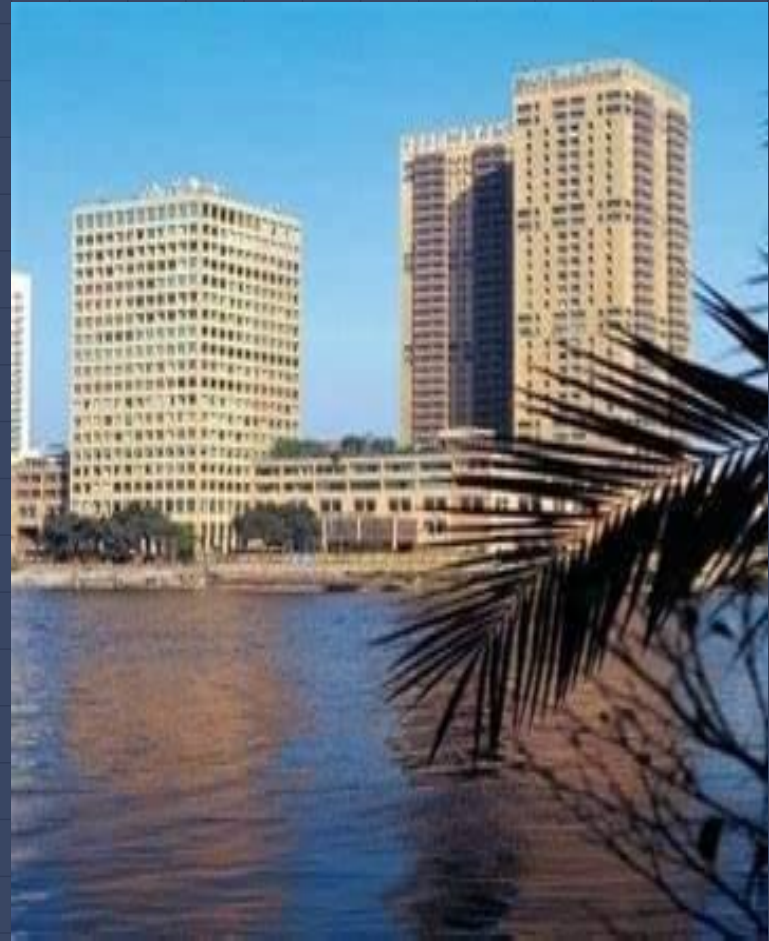

How to do business in Egypt ?

Egypt is a great place to start or expand your business. The country enjoys a welcoming business environment; offering protection, enormous growth opportunities besides a long list of incentives offered by the government for foreign companies



Egypt is the third largest economy in the Arab world. Services are the most important sector of the economy and account for around 47.5% of total GDP. The most important segments within Services are Wholesale and Retail Trade (10% of the output) , Government (9%) , Transportation and Communication (8%) , Finance Insurance and Real Estate (8%) and Tourism (4%) . Industry constitutes 30% of the output and the largest segments within this sector are : Manufacturing (15.5%) and Extraction (13.5%). Agriculture accounts for 14.5% of output and Electricity, Water, Sanitation and Construction for around 7% .

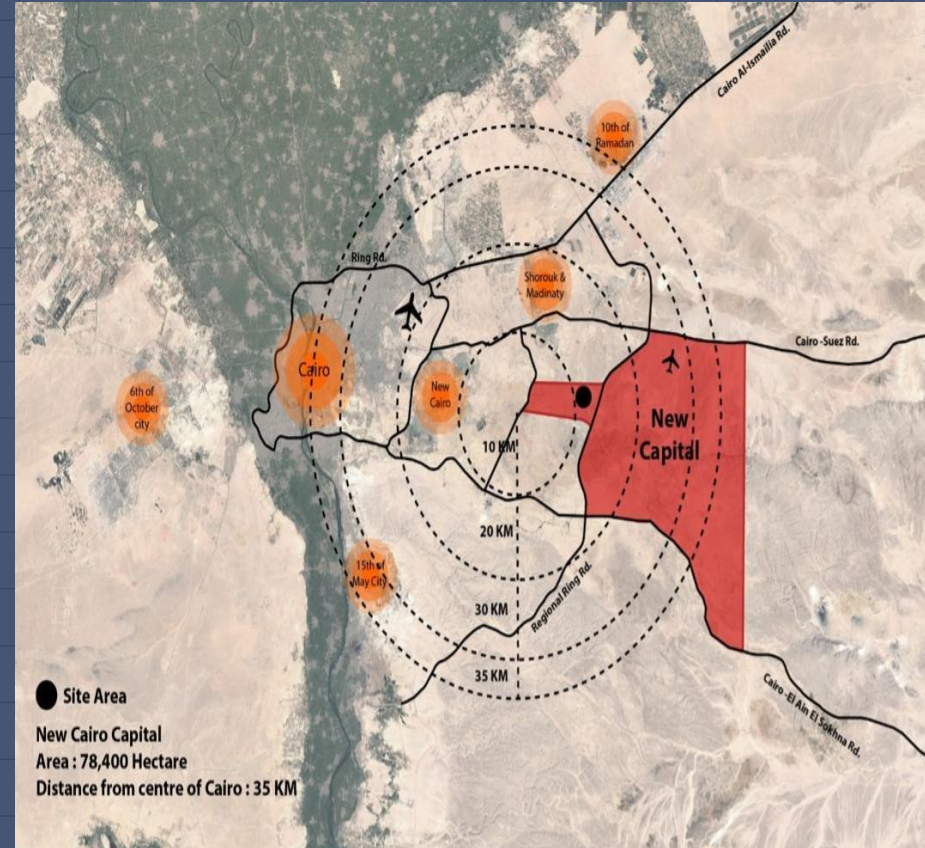

Strategic location:

New Cairo capital city is located 35 KM east of Cairo of a total area of 170,000 feddan. The new capital city lies between the regional ring road, the Cairo-Suez road and Cairo-El Ain El Sokhna road.

The new capital city will help to strengthen and diversify the country's economic potential by creating new places to live, work and visit. In order to draw people to this new capital city, a series of key catalyst developments will be established at its core. This will include a new government administrative district, a cultural district and a wide variety of urban neighbourhoods .

Fertilizers	Articles of apparel , knit or crocheted
Edible vegetables and certain roots and tubers	Glass and glassware
Vegetable, fruit , nut food preparations	Cotton
Articles of iron or steel	Carpets and other textile floor covering

Mineral fuels, oils, distillation products	Oil seed, oleagic fruits, grain, seed, fruits
Machinery, nuclear reactors, boilers	Articles of Iron or steel
Cereals	Meat and edible meat offal
Vehicles other than railways, tramways	Organic chemicals
Electrical, electronic equipment	Wood and articles of wood, wood charcoal
Plastics	Paper and paperboard, articles of pulp , paper and board
Iron and steel	Animal, vegetable fats and oils , cleavage products
Pharmaceutical products	Man-made filaments
